Dr. Moustakis is a Professor of Operations Management at the Technical University of Crete (TUC), (Greece), School of Production Engineering and Management (<http://www.pem.tuc.gr/4040.html>) and Director of the Management Systems Laboratory ([www.logistics.tuc.gr](http://www.logistics.tuc.gr)). He is also affiliated with the Open University of Greece as Academic Course Coordinator and Tutor in *Management* and with the Democritus University of Thrace, interdisciplinary postgraduate program of studies in *Systems Engineering Management*. In the past he has served on the Faculty of the School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, at the George Washington University (USA) as Assistant Research Professor and Assistant Professorial Lecturer. Between 1987 and 2010 he was a Principal Researcher at the Foundation for Research and Technology – Hellas (FORTH), Institute of Computer Science, Heraklion, Greece. He has advised private companies and government agencies in Greece and the European Union in operations management, economic and cost analysis and information systems and has served on the Staff of the Economic Advisor to the Prime Minister of Greece. In connection to his work in information systems and operations management he has received grants from European Commission (EC), the Greek Secretariat for Research and Technology and private industry from Greece and abroad. He has served as Expert in program formulation and proposal assessment in the EC and in Greece. Since 1989 he has managed numerous R&D projects with total budget around 4 million Euros. He has successfully supervised 11 completed PhD theses at TUC and has served on the steering committee or examination board of numerous PhD and MSc theses in Greece, in Europe and in Egypt. Since 1988 he has supervised *numerous* Diploma and Master theses at the Technical University of Crete and the Democritus University of Thrace. He has contributed to the organization of numerous scientific international conferences as Chair, member of the scientific program committee, and keynote speaker.

His current research interests include management, supply chain management, management of organizational innovation and creativity, economic analysis and cost engineering, application of information systems, and bioinformatics (with special emphasis in the integration of microarray data with gene regulatory networks). In the past he has been active in machine learning, human factors and business excellence research. His teaching portfolio includes management, supply chain management, engineering economic analysis; life cycle cost assessment; human resource management; and, project management. Teaching has received very good to excellent ratings from students.

Dr. Moustakis is an elected member of the Council of the Technical University of Crete.

He is fluent in English and Greek and has a fair command of French. He was born on October 15, 1955; he is married and father of three children, aged 27, 20 and 17 years.
