St. Petersburg is the second largest city in Russia after its capital - Moscow, with the population of about 6 million people. It is one of the most beautiful cities in the world. St. Petersburg is a center of cultural, historical, and architectural landmarks. Founded by Tsar Peter I (the Great) as Russia's "window on Europe," it bears the unofficial status of Russia's cultural capital. The Hermitage Museum ranks among the best museums of West European art in the World. Moreover, the bridges and natural canals of the river have earned St. Petersburg the nickname "Venice of the North." Because of St. Petersburg's northerly location, the city enjoys the "White Nights," from June 11 to July 2, when daylight extends to nearly 19 hours--another of St. Petersburg's most acclaimed characteristics.
