We are proud to say that after four very successful years, our Model EU became one of the largest and most recognized simulations of the European Union in the world.





BEUM 2016 topics

Apart from providing our participants with valuable knowledge and skills, we tend to introduce them with very current and interesting topics that will be discussed on the simulation. This year, the main focus will be on the economic and migrant crises, as well as Brexit. Participants simulating the work of the European Council on BEUM 2015 will be discussing **the economic implications of Brexit on the EU**, while the participants in the European Parliament and the Council of the EU will amend two legislative proposals: **Regulation on the European Border and Coast Guard** and **Regulation on the European Union Agency for Asylum**.

The novelty of this edition will be the simulation of the European Court of Justice whose participants will discuss the interesting case of Google vs. Spanish Data Protection Agency on the thought-provoking Right to be forgotten.

BEUM 2016 offers a valuable educational experience, by being an efficient tool for learning more about the decision making procedures within the EU. Students are given the opportunity to experience theory in practice, which will enable them to better understand the political cooperation as well as the composition of the EU bodies. Also, BEUM 2016 brings the best students from the whole world together, helping them to connect professionally and academically, through an interactive dialogue and exchanging of experiences. This year, we will connect our participants with the Continent's most prominent experts and allow them to have their say on the current striking issues in Europe.
