
International Cooperation

Languages: French



UPEC offers:

- Free French classes for international exchange students (1 to 6 ECTS)
- Three levels : elementary, intermediate, advanced

STUDENT LIFE



Variety of services to support students in their academic and professional endeavors

- Information and communication facilities: computer rooms, e-learning modules, on-line courses, on-line library, 12 libraries
- Job placement and career services Department
- Department dedicated to helping students with their **daily life:** accommodation, student jobs, financial assistance, etc.
- Healthcare university network 'RÉSUS' to provide easy access to medical services for all students.

Cultural and sport activities

- 18 cultural workshops: modern art, dance, communication, photography, orchestra, poetry, etc. (some of them can offer credits)
- Partnership with the Maison des Arts Créteil which allows students and staff to receive reduced rates for certain performances.
- More than 30 sporting activities are available as leisure and cross-disciplinary activities: badminton, football, handball, yoga, swimming, tennis, etc.

Community life

- Student associations (about 40 at UPEC) where you can meet other students, share a passion, ideas, organize and obtain funding for projects.
- Student elections: Elected students are present in all instances and at all levels of the university to participate in the university life, be informed about problems and defend their rights.





FSEG



- This 3rd and last year of our Licence 3 degree in International Management (Licence Economie Gestion Parcours Management International) entirely taught in English.
- One year full-time program in management with one semester in France at IAE Eiffel and one semester in one of our partner universities in Europe or overseas.
- Dedicated to French students, to international "free mover" students, with a two years degree or 120 ECTS in Economics, Management and Social Sciences but also open to international students enrolled in Erasmus+
- Designed to provide basic skills in the core areas of business administration as well as an understanding of concepts and techniques in several disciplines of management (Human resource management, finance, operational management, management of information system, accounting and control).
- Foreign students have also the opportunity to learn French at UPEC and all students can study during their exchange semester in another language (English, German, Spanish, Portuguese, Russian...)
- The opportunity to gain international, transferable skills for the work place by working in groups of students from diverse national and cultural backgrounds
- The courses take place in the main campus of UPEC, just 25 minutes from the heart of Paris (Bastille).
- Strong student involvement, through active participation, personal involvement, and teamwork.
- Courses consisting of a mix of lectures, readings, case studies and discussions.
- All resources from Harvard Business School made available to students.





- Emphasis on the development of analytical skills, critical thinking and written and oral skills.
- Faculty members are international Professors, Researchers, Managers, Entrepreneurs and Senior Lecturers who all share with enthusiasm their international experience.
- According to their grades, at the end of this nationally recognized Licence 3 program, with 180 ECTS, students can apply to a Master's of our IAE Gustave Eiffel (Marketing, Finance, and Management).
- They also can apply to any French IAE programs or to other Master's degree in France (Universities, "Grandes Ecoles") or abroad

Academic Performance Requirements

Attendance:

Attendance for all courses is mandatory.

If a student misses more than 1/5th of the sessions of a given course, the student will receive a grade of 0/20 for coursework and participation.

If the student's absence is justified, the Jury can exceptionally decide, after looking in detail at the student's situation, to give the student credit for classwork and participation in the course.

Absence from examinations:

A student absent from a midterm will be declared "défaillant" (defaulting). In this case, the student will be required to sit a make-up examination (in June).

To receive a Licence 3:

- In order to successfully complete the Licence 3, the student must obtain at least an average of 10 (out of 20)
- The average is calculated using the grades from all courses, weighted in terms of number of credits per course.
- The student who successfully completes the Licence 3 is declared "admis" (passing)).
- In this case, "mentions" (distinctions) are granted based on the student's average: Average "Mention"
